The Bevel Bar: The Door Knocker Margarita

- 1 cup tequila
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup fresh lime juice
- 1/2 cup orange liqueur
- 1/2 cup cranberry juice

1. Stir together all ingredients until sugar is dissolved.
2. Pour desired amount of mixture into a cocktail shaker filled with ice cubes.
3. Cover with lid, and shake 30 seconds.
4. Strain into chilled cocktail glasses.
5. Repeat with remaining mixture. Serve immediately (or make ahead; see tip below).

Tip: Mix up several batches 3 to 4 hours before the party starts, and chill in decorative bottles or pitchers, ready to shake and serve when guests arrive.
